Preparing for Your "Ark on Wheels" Visit

During your program, Noah's Landing staff members will introduce a variety of animals from across the globe. Besides learning about our animals and their unique stories, your students will learn some basic vocabulary about habitats, adaptations and conservation. We hope you'll use our visit as a way to continue to talk about life science throughout the year.

We'll need your help to ensure the health and safety of our animals and your classroom. Here are a few rules and guidelines to review before our visit.

The classroom should be a calm and quiet place when the animals enter the room. This will help them relax and ensure their cooperation throughout the day.

Our guides will be sharing facts and stories about each animal. Children should be quiet and attentive to ensure enough time for interaction.

"Ark on Wheels" is an interactive program. To ensure the safety of our animals, we ask that children "sanitize" their hands before and after the program. We'll need your help to make sure children keep their hands and fingers away from their face throughout the presentation.

To ensure everyone walks out with the same number of fingers that they walked in with, we ask that children wait to "touch" until the guide gives permission. We also ask that they refrain from poking, pulling or striking the animals.

We love interaction! Kids should feel encouraged to ask questions and get involved.

Everyone should have fun!
